CV Bean Bag League Rules

- All equipment must meet specifications & the court layout distances must be followed as outlined in the ACA rules (a link to the ACA rules is on the league website).
- Each location must have two sets of boards (2 per set), bags (8 per set), and scoring sticks (1 per set) for each match being played available each night of league play.
- The visiting team is allowed to bring their own set(s) of bags to play with, but enough bags must be provided to allow the home team the opportunity to use them also. The home team can decline & choose to use their own bags, but the visiting team must make the offer regardless.
- Twelve games will be played each league night, with the team with the majority of wins taking the payback.
- In case of a 6-6 tie after twelve games, each team will select two of their own players to face-off in a one game tiebreaker to determine a winner.
- The first team to 21 points after both players have thrown all four of their bags is that game's winner. Teams are allowed to go over 21 points without penalty.
- Roll-ons are NOT allowed in any form.
- No player substitutions are allowed once the match has begun, unless approved by the opposing team. Any games played with a non-approved substitute player will be marked as a loss.
- All matches are scheduled to start at 7:00. A grace period of 15 minutes is permitted to all players.
- The season will consist of 18 weeks, with each team playing every other team once & playing their other "home" team twice.
- All effort should be made to play on the scheduled night regardless of weather, however each home team is in charge of making the final decision on whether to play or not.
- Please make an effort to reschedule any matches missed due to inclement weather or other issues as soon as possible.
